The IEPA Bureau of Water has prepared a draft National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit for Hillsboro Energy, L.L.C. for Deer Run Mine. The address of the discharger is Hillsboro Energy, L.L.C., 925 South Main Street, Hillsboro, IL. 62049. The facility is in Montgomery County, 1 mile southeast of Hillsboro, Illinois.

Illinois EPA is holding this hearing for the purpose of taking comments on the draft permit prior to taking final action on the permit application. Issues relevant to this proceeding include the antidegradation analysis and the applicant's compliance with requirements of the federal Clean Water Act and Subtitles C and D, 35 Illinois Adm. Code. Because Illinois is mandated by state law to issue a permit if the applicant meets the requirements for obtaining a permit, those recommending denial of the permit application should be prepared to state the regulation that is the basis of their recommendation. Issues related to the mining operations are not relevant in this proceeding and should be directed to the Illinois Department of Natural Resources, Office of Mines and Minerals.

The applicant proposes a new refuse disposal area associated with the existing underground coal mine (SIC 1222). Mine operations result in the discharge of alkaline mine drainage. Application is made for two (2) new discharges which are located in Montgomery County, Illinois.
